#### Provide a description of the evaluation activities completed during the fiscal year

Three components contributed to the First 5 Madera County "Evaluation Activities" for the 2012-2013 fiscal year. They are: 1) Statewide Evaluation, 2) Evaluation Plans, and 3) Evaluation tools. Each component has facilitated the evaluation process, increasing the quality of evaluation outcomes for First 5 Madera County. A description of each "Evaluation Activity" is below. In 2005-2006 the implementation of the First 5 California "New Evaluation Framework" served as a building block for First 5 Madera County's evaluation design. Prior to the closure of the 2005-2006 fiscal year, First 5 Madera County staff met one-on-one with each funded program to ensure programs were accurately aligned with a First 5 California result area and service. Once a result area and service was aligned to a funded program, First 5 Madera County staff created excel documents titled "Exhibit 1" to mimic First 5 California's "Part 2: Appendix C" forms. Funded programs reported quarterly on "Exhibit 1" forms to demonstrate populations served and quarterly expenditures. By utilizing the "Exhibit 1" forms, First 5 Madera County is able to demonstrate, on a quarterly basis and year-to-date information in Quarter 4. This system of evaluation has been utilized since 2005-2006 to present.

The ultimate goal of each Evaluation Plan is to "tell" the program's "story" of the impact of the service provided to young children and their families. The Evaluation Plans ensure that each funded program is capturing outcomes, aligned with the First 5 Strategic Plan Hierarchy. Evaluation Plans have been tailored to assess each funded program. Each Evaluation Plan has the following eight sections:1)Program Goals,2)Strategic Plan Objectives:3)Result Indicators:4)Data Collection Methods and Tools:5)Frequency and Schedule of Data Collection6)Frequency That Data Is Submitted To First 5:7)Who Is Responsible For Data Collection:8)Sampling Strategy: First 5 Madera County funded programs utilize different evaluation tools to demonstrate outcomes. Two forms of evaluation tools are used by funded programs: 1) Recognized Evaluation Tools and 2) First 5 Madera County Children and Families Commission form or the "CFC Form".

1)Recognized Evaluation Tools

Most First 5 Madera County funded programs utilize Recognized Evaluation and Assessment Tools. Tools that have been utilized by First 5 Madera County funded program are: Tools that have been utilized by First 5 Madera County funded program are: 1) Early Child Care Environmental Rating Scale (ECCERS), 2) Family Child Care Environmental Rating Scale (FCCERS), 3) Infant Toddler Environmental Rating Scale (ITERS), 4) Denver II, 5) Ages and Stages, 6) NCAST Feeding and Teaching, 7) Life Skill Progression Tool, 8) Structured Decision Making Tool, 9)Parent Survey, and 10)Desired Results Developmental Profile-Revised (DRDP-R-10)11) Denver 12) NCAST feeding and teaching scale.

2)First 5 Madera County Children and Families Commission Form, or the "CFC Form" First 5 staff created excel documents titled "CFC Form," which serve as uniquely tailored data entry systems for each funded program. To create a "CFC Form" for a funded program, First 5 staff met one- on-one with each funded program to determine what items to include on the "CFC Forms" to accurately "tell" the "story" of each funded program. The "CFC Form" is a simple data entry system that allows for case management, support services, referrals, trainings, and outcomes of assessment tools.

Providers (child care, preschool teachers, and general service providers that work with children and families for individuals that provide infant mental health)

#### What were the types of services provided?

17 licensed child care providers participated in the event. Upon completion of the training, Providers participated in a purchasing event to ensure that their facilities were developmentally appropriate. 12 providers participated in a 10 month long Infant Mental Health Program. The providers would then convene one week after the training to discuss the topic from the training, we called these meetings "Breakfast and Brainstorming." The CSP staff collecting information regarding ECE needs.

#### What was the intended result of the service? What was the community impact of the service?

The intended result of these programs was to build provider capacity as a result 89 children 0-5 that are in the programs benefited from developmentally appropriate environments. FCCERS-R pre scores were 6.28 and were 6.40 at post.

The intended result of the Breakfast and Brainstorming was met, the facilitator of the group was able to write a report of the assets and gaps of Infant Mental Health in our community. The CSP staff was able to survey ECE sites in Madera and collect information regarding the assets and gaps in Madera.

404 preschool aged children were screened by a dentist. Of those screened 37% (n=150) did not have a dental home. Of those that did not have a dental home 49% (73) needed dental services. 32% (n=24) had decay in 4 or more teeth and 68% (n=50) had decay in 4 or less teeth.

This data will serve as a baseline for future program development.
